National Museums and Monuments: Nest Record Card

1. Every nest with eggs or young or fledged birds still being fed by parents, should be recorded provided that the contents have been counted accurately on at least one day, or, if this is impossible, that the date of laying, hatching or of the young leaving the nest Cards should not be completed for nests in which no eggs are laid, or for which none

of the above information is available. Separate cards should be completed for nests

- used more than once. 2. Under "Locality" give the place (town, river, etc.) where the nest is found, with coordinates if possible.
 - 3. (a) Fill in one line for each visit.
 - (b) Only one visit need be recorded each day, unless some change has taken place between the first and later visit. (c) Use symbols of for male, of for female, of for sitting, B for building, F for feeding, and
 - any combination of these symbols. 4. Record only what you have observed - please make no progress.
